# Botanicus Interior Landscaping for Niagara County Community College Culinary Institute

**Artificial plants and flowers used:** Artificial balfour aralias, custom built 10'-11' Olive Trees, Silk pothos, Artificial cedar cone topiaries, assorted silk grasses, artificial olive bushes, basil bushes, silk Danica ivy burgundy/green medium/long vine, custom built weeping Ficus trees, artificial false aralia bushes, artificial Spathiphyllum, custom made Ming aralia cascade, assorted artificial succulents, artificial Aglaonemas.

**Manufacturers/brokers used:** Custom Made Trees from Botanicus Interior Landscaping; Allstate Floral; May Silk.

**Containers used:** #PHSQ-1717, #PHSQ-2020, #PHSQ-1212, #PP-1632, #PP-3232 Matte Black Phoenix; #ART-3612 Matte Black Athena; Architectural Supplements – All Matte Black; 24" Planter Boxes – Topsiders – Matte Black.

**Topdressing:** Aspen moss

**Other materials:** Hard foam/spray foam from foam machine

A Niagara Falls abandoned multi level mall was magnificently transformed by Niagara Community College into the Culinary Institute of Niagara Falls.

Kitchen, classrooms, restaurant and 5 story center atrium were enhanced with an assortment of specially designed artificial trees, bushes, flowers and vines. The Tuscan theme was complimented with 10'+ Olive trees, grape ivy vines, rosemary and basil.

The railings were graced with long pothos vines on all levels. The 2<sup>nd</sup> floor shelves donned planters with mixed foliage visible throughout the atrium. The café wall was accented with plant portraits and a variety of bush and hanging succulents!!

The installation was required before construction was completed. The plants in the interim were used for traffic pattern control and sectioning off safe areas.
